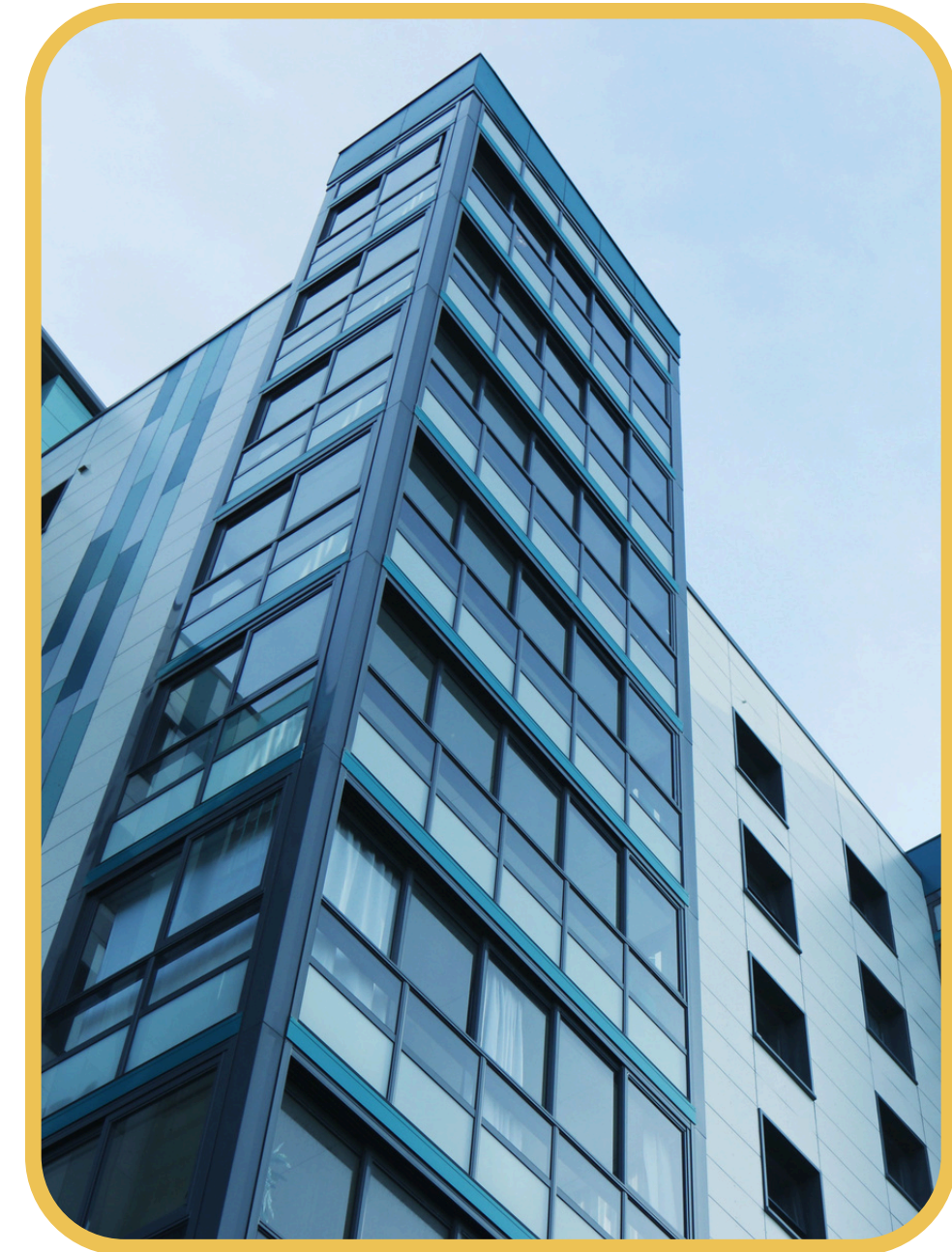

The wrong cleaning company can cost your business far more than the monthly invoice.

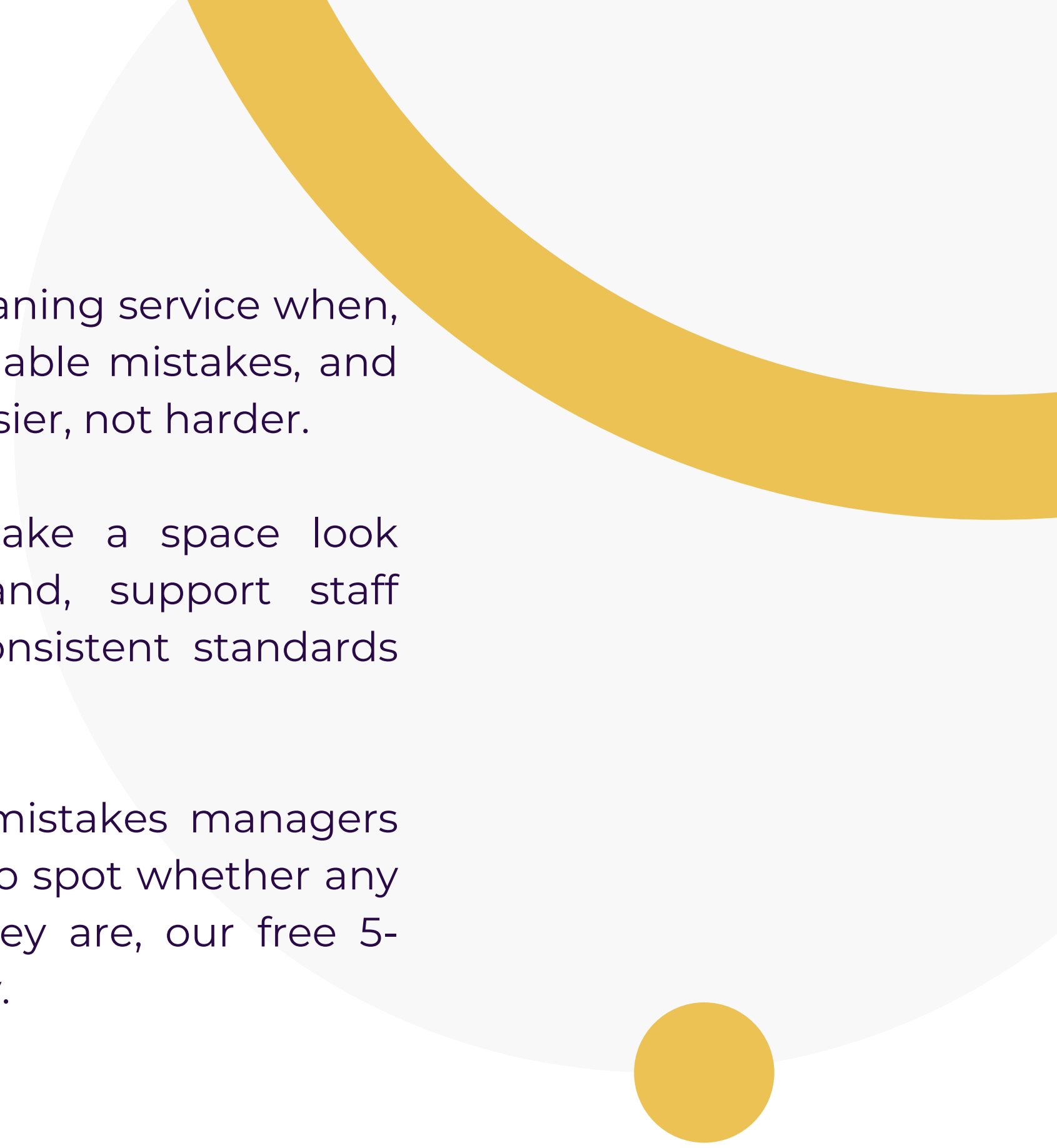
It can cost you time, it can cost you credibility.

MISTAKE 1

CHOOSING THE CHEAPEST QUOTE WITHOUT ASSESSING REAL VALUE

Why it happens:

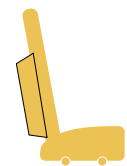
Managers under pressure to reduce overheads often default to the lowest quote available, especially for non-core areas like cleaning.



The real risk:



Poorly trained or high-turnover staff.



Substandard equipment and low-quality products.



Missed cleaning standards, especially in less visible areas.



Reputational damage from inconsistent presentation.



Costly rework and time spent chasing fixes.



What to do:

- Request a detailed scope of work — not just a flat price.
- Ask what's included: cleaning frequency, supervision, consumables, special services.
- Compare service delivery, reporting, and accountability measures.

The cheapest quote isn't always the most cost-effective — sometimes it's the beginning of an ongoing headache.

MISTAKE 2





Not Checking Insurance, Registrations & Compliance

Why it happens:

Many assume that if a business has an ABN and a logo, it's fully compliant. But in the cleaning industry, unregistered subcontracting and lack of insurance are common.



The real risk:

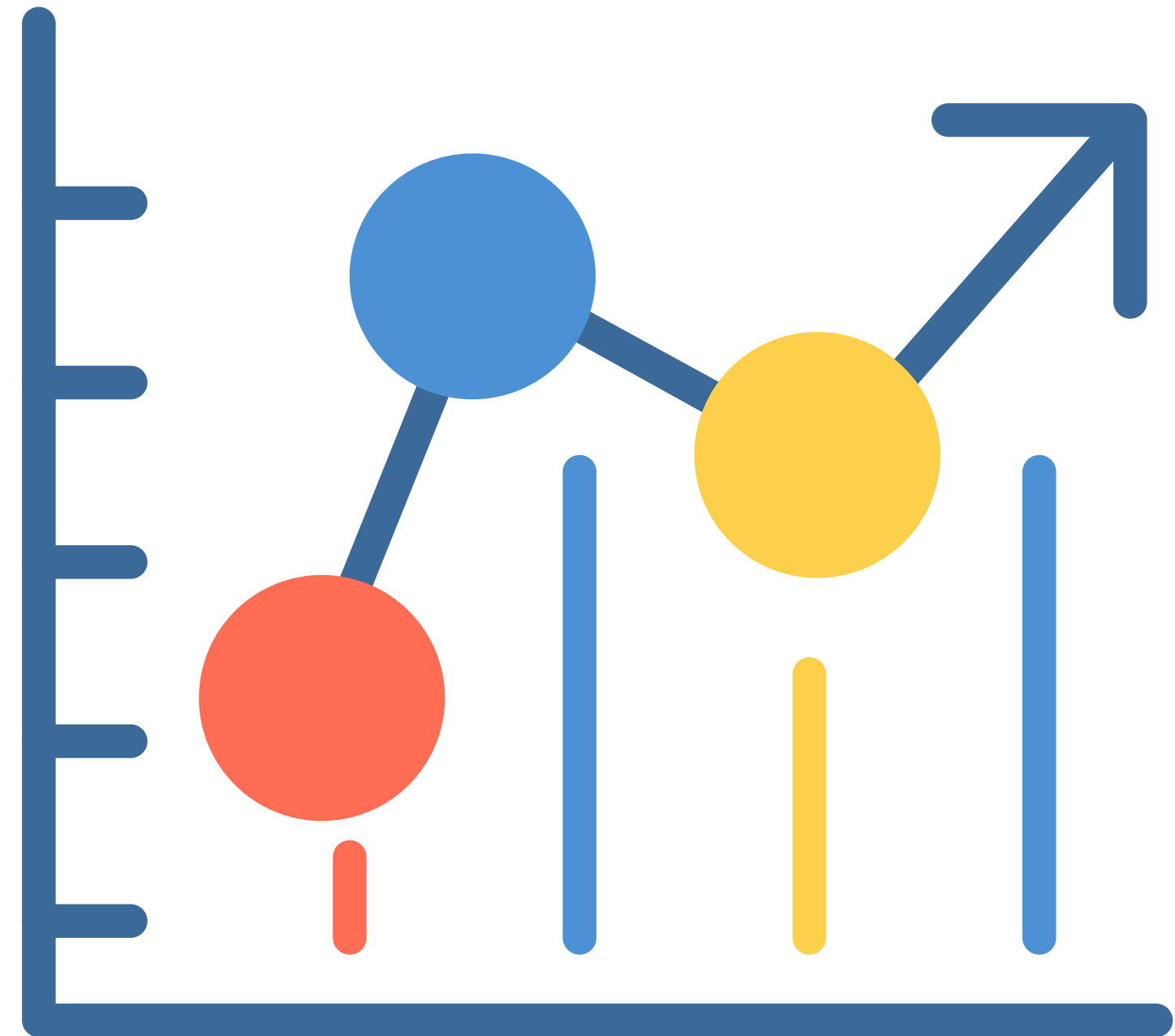
-  You may be liable if an incident or injury occurs onsite.
-  No workers compensation cover for cleaners.
-  Breach of your business's WHS (Work Health & Safety) obligations.
-  Potential penalties under Fair Work Australia or local state regulations.



What to do:

- Request up-to-date Public Liability and Workers Compensation certificates.
- Verify ABN and business registration details on the ABN Lookup.
- Ensure cleaners are directly employed or have proper sub-contracting agreements.

Compliance isn't a bonus — it's your legal safety net.

MISTAKE 3

Poor Communication with the Cleaning Team



Why it happens:

There's often a belief that "cleaning is simple" and doesn't need close communication. This leads to misalignment.

The real risk:



Key areas may be overlooked (boardrooms, stockrooms, IT rooms).



Cleaners operate without knowing daily priorities or changes.



Allergies or sensitivities to products go unnoticed.



Failure to adjust services for events, rearrangements, or special access.





When communication fails, cleaning standards slip — and complaints rise.

What to do:

- Establish a single point of contact (preferably a supervisor).
- Use simple task checklists or logbooks.
- Hold short quarterly reviews to improve alignment and satisfaction.





MISTAKE 4

Not Tracking Quality with KPIs or Reporting

Why it happens:

Cleaning is often seen as a “background” task with no measurable output — until something goes wrong.

The real risk:



Inconsistency between shifts and teams.



No transparency on what's done or missed.



Inability to justify costs or service continuation to leadership.



Internal staff dissatisfaction due to declining cleanliness.



What to do:

Request regular quality audits and photo-logged reports.

- Track simple KPIs such as:
- Cleaning checklist completion rate
- Response time to corrective actions
- Incident reports and resolutions
- Staff satisfaction via QR feedback points

You can't improve what you don't measure.

MISTAKE 5

Hiring Without Considering Workplace Culture & Professionalism

Why it happens:

Some managers treat cleaning like a mechanical task, without considering how it affects the business atmosphere.

Disruption of work during meetings or sensitive hours.



Poor conduct in client-facing or restricted areas.



Negative impact on staff morale and corporate image.



What to do:

- Observe the team before hiring — presentation and behaviour matter.
- Ask about training specific to corporate environments (punctuality, discretion).
- Prioritise companies that onboard their staff to your culture and policies.

Cleaners are part of your workplace ecosystem — they should reflect your brand standards.

If they don't, the issue is bigger than cleaning — it becomes a reflection of your business. That's exactly the kind of gap we help identify in our visual audit.
